# CHANGES INCORPORATED INTO THE AMPS® JANUARY-JUNE 2014 QUESTIONNAIRE

Following is a summary of the changes to the contents as agreed upon in the compilation of AMPS<sup>®</sup>, RAMS<sup>®</sup> and the Product Research & Activities questionnaires for January-June 2014.

#### 1.2 Electronic Media

## **Television**

#### Terrestrial:

Platinum TV has been added to the list of terrestrial channels.

## Satellite:

There have been major changes in the field of satellite television. In addition to DStv, 3 new satellite services have been launched. New questions on these satellite services have been added to the questionnaire.

- StarSat is a new pay satellite service and has replaced the TopTV satellite service. TopTV has ceased to exist.
- FREEVISION is a new free satellite TV service, for which one has to pay only for the decoder and
  its installation.
- OPENVIEW HD (OVHD) is a new free satellite TV service, for which one has to pay only for the decoder and its installation.

The wording of the question that establishes which satellite services can be received in the household, has been adjusted to cater for the new free-to-air services.

# i) DStv:

The number of channels for the various DStv subscription options has been updated.

The description of the DStv HD PVR has been updated and a picture of the new DStv Explora HD decoder has been added to the DStv HD Decoder showscreen.

The option to claim a DUAL-VIEW DStv decoder has been removed.

The DStv on Demand/CatchUp service is now simply referred to as DStv Catch Up.

The list of DStv channels now includes the channel numbers, and are now shown in channel number order instead of alphabetically.

# ii) StarSat (previously TopTV):

The new StarSat questions which replaced TopTV, uncover:

- Which of the 3 package options are subscribed to, namely StarSat Special, StarSat Smart
  or StarSat Super. The approximate number of channels and payment per month for each of
  these options is provided.
- Whether the StarSat subscription is currently being paid for or not; some people choose not to pay their subscriptions every month, if they are going to be away or for some other reason.
- Whether the StarSat subscription is paid for by account or with a pre-paid voucher.
- Whether either of the Cultural packages StarSat Indian or StarSat Chinese is being subscribed to, at a cost over and above the regular StarSat subscription.
- Whether or not there is a StarSat decoder actively IN USE in the household.
- Whether or not there is a TopTV decoder actively IN USE in the household. (This question remains on the questionnaire as the TopTV decoder can also be used for StarSat.)

New television viewing questions on StarSat replaced the previous TopTV viewing questions, and they establish which StarSat channels have personally been viewed in the past 4 weeks, the past 7 days and yesterday.

The StarSat list of channels includes 93 standard channels, 16 StarSat Chinese only channels and 8 StarSat Indian only channels. The Chinese and Indian package channels are only shown to respondents who claim subscription for these.

# iii) FREEVISION (New):

A new question has been added to establish whether or not there is a FREEVISION decoder/set-top box actively IN USE in the household.

New television viewing questions on FREEVISION have been added to establish which FREEVISION channels have personally been viewed in the past 4 weeks, the past 7 days and yesterday.

The list of channels on this service is in alphabetical order.

## iv) OPENVIEW HD (OVHD) (New):

A new question has been added to establish whether or not there is an OPENVIEW HD (OVHD) decoder/set-top box actively IN USE in the household.

New television viewing questions on OPENVIEW HD (OVHD) have been added to establish which OPENVIEW HD channels have personally been viewed in the past 4 weeks, the past 7 days and yesterday.

The list of channels on this service is in alphabetical order.

The wording of the question about any other decoders/"set-top" boxes has been revised to exclude DStv, M-Net, TopTV, StarSat, OPENVIEW HD and FREEVISION.

In the list of places where TV can be viewed, "inside a taxi" has been expanded to "inside a taxi/bus".

#### Radio

The list of radio stations has been updated according to the new January - June 2014 diary. (See 3. RADIO DIARY below)

## 2. PRODUCTS/SERVICES

# 2.1 Cellphone

A new activity has been added to the list of cellphone activities to establish when last, if at all, the respondent "received and redeemed any retail or electronic coupons/vouchers or promotional airtime vouchers."

# 2.2 Digital

Two new activities were added to the digital activities section:

- Use/access maps/directions (GPS)
- Check the weather

Two changes were made to the options on how the respondent accesses the Internet:

- "Mobile network" has been extended to "Cellphone/mobile network"
- A new option was added: "At someone else's home"

#### 2.3 Motor Vehicles

Pirelli was added to the list of brands of car tyres.

# 2.4 Financial Services

The finance section has undergone significant changes:

The following **new questions** have been added:

- Whether the respondent has/makes use of a SASSA government grant card.
- Whether the respondent personally has a loyalty store card with which he/she can earn loyalty points.
- Whether the respondent belongs to a burial society.
- Funeral insurance has been removed from the list of policies and investment plans, and is now a
  new stand-alone question, establishing if the respondent personally has funeral insurance/a
  funeral policy from a formal financial institution (excluding funeral/burial cover provided by their
  employer/company).
- An additional question establishes with which companies the respondent has the funeral insurance/policy. A list of companies is provided, which includes Assupol Life, AVBOB, Doves and other companies.

The following **changes** have been made to existing questions:

• The question asking which financial services the respondent has/uses, has been expanded to state that we refer to those services provided by formal financial institutions.

- In the list of financial services, Revolving Credit has been removed from the Overdraft Facility/ Revolving Credit option and "ATM card" added to the Debit/Cheque card option.
- The definition of a personal loan has been amended to read as follows: "A general loan from a
  formal financial institution that can be used for any purpose excluding home loans, vehicle
  finance and student loans."
- The financial products offered by individual financial institutions, have been updated.
- The question asking "Which ONE bank do you regard as your main bank for all your banking transactions?" has been simplified to "Which ONE bank do you regard as your main bank?"
- The retail store card question has been expanded to explain that the retail store card allows you to buy on credit.
- The medical aid question, "Are you a member of a medical aid scheme usually via your or a family member's employer?" has been shortened to "Are you on a medical aid scheme usually via your or a family member's employer?"
- The list of medical aid companies has been updated to include GEMS and POLMED. In addition, a "Don't know" option has been provided.
- Mutual fund has been removed from the question: "Do you have an investment in unit trusts or a mutual fund?"
- The question on policies and investment plans has been completely reworked and stresses that benefits such as pensions, provident funds and group life cover provided by the employer, are excluded.

The list of policies has been updated, and concise definitions of these are provided on the showscreens. The policies and investment plans measured are:

- Life Cover Policy
- Disability Cover
- o Sever illness/Dread disease cover
- Medical Insurance (not a Medical Aid)
- Credit Life
- Retirement Annuity (Pre-Retirement)
- Annuity (Post-Retirement)
- Preservation Fund
- Education Policy/Plan
- Savings or Investment Policy/Plan
- Assupol Life and AVBOB have been added to the list of companies with which the respondent may have policies/investments/insurance. The option for "Informal companies/societies" has been removed.
- AA, Guardrisk, iWyze and Virgin have been added to the list of short term insurance companies. "ABSA Insurance" has been renamed "ABSA iDirect".

# 2.5 Furniture/Appliances

In the list of electronic devices:

- "iPod" has been expanded to "Apple iPod"
- "Samsung Galaxy" was adjusted to "Samsung Galaxy Tab" in the list of tablet examples.

## 2.6 Food and Groceries

Game and Foodco have been combined in the list of stores.

## 2.7 Travel

FlySafair has been added to the list of local airlines, while 1time and Velvet Sky have been removed.

# 2.8 Clothing/Shoes

Edgars Active has been added to the list of stores where one can buy clothing/shoes.
